### BRDHC Employees Recognized by Algoma Public Health

**BLIND RIVER, ON:** Blind River District Health Centre employees were recognized by Algoma Public Health (APH) on Wednesday March 3, 2010 for improvements in influenza immunization.

Awards received included:

- Most Improved Number of Staff Immunized Against Influenza (from 70% in 2008 to 82% in 2009).
- Highest Number of Long-Term Care Staff Immunized Against Influenza (94%).

Jonathon Bouma, Director of Infection Control, presented the awards on behalf of Algoma Public Health to Janet Demers, Infection Control Nurse at the Blind River District Health Centre.

Algoma Public Health Awards are handed out on a yearly basis to recipients in the APH region.
